They will join us in the rich tradition of honoring graduates from one of the nation's premier school districts at the 2012 Parkway Alumni Association Hall of Fame Gala on **November 17, 2012**.

The Parkway Alumni Association is currently accepting nominations for the 2012 Parkway Alumni Association Hall of Fame. Completed nomination forms must be submitted by **February 15, 2012** for a graduate to be considered for this honor.

Criteria for Eligibility

1. Nominees must have graduated from Parkway at least ten years prior to nomination. Posthumous nominations will be considered as well. Parkway graduates are encouraged to self-nominate.
2. Nominees will be evaluated for a lifetime of excellence, accomplishment and recognition in their field or fields. Their accomplishments and achievements should be recorded on the application form and resume attached.
3. Candidates will be contacted by the Selection Committee to verify data on accompanying documentation and must also give consent for consideration.

Guidelines

1. Nominations will be accepted through **February 15, 2012**. Selections will be announced by **June 2012**.
2. The goal of the Selection Committee, comprised of current and former teachers, coaches, alumni and administrators, is to make its decisions based solely on the contents of the applications. Therefore, please be both accurate and thorough. To ensure fairness in the process, the Committee reserves the right to research and verify any and all information.
3. Distinguished Alumni will be recognized at a gala event on **November 17, 2012**; each individual will receive a personal award; and a permanent tribute will be displayed at their alma mater.
4. Current members of the Hall of Fame Committee, Alumni Association Board of Directors, Board of Education and elected officials who, by virtue of their position, can directly influence funding for the Parkway School District, are not eligible for this award.
